

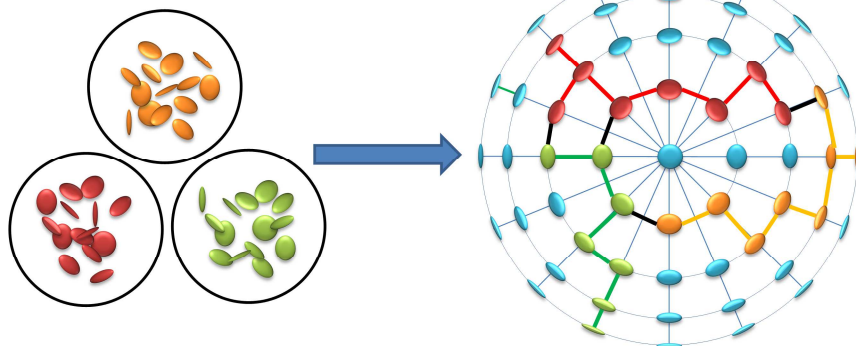
Dr Gordon Niven
